Community Update and Elmwood Tidbits:

May is finally here, and we are beginning to wrap up the school year. Testing is wrapping up and each building is preparing for its end of year awards and activities. This is always a busy time of the year, and at the same time, we need to keep students focused as they are starting to look forward to summer break. If you would like information on your child's award assembly, please contact the appropriate building for details. I would stress to each of you to set a goal for your child to continue reading all summer long. Research clearly shows that students, who read throughout the summer, have less regression when the new school year starts. Finally, just to put First Night Open House on your radar, we are changing this from our usual Monday night to Thursday, August 16th from 4 to 7 PM. School will then start on Monday, August 20th.

This summer, the administration and Board of Education is looking at enhancing the safety of our building. The main project will be designed to create holding areas at the front two entrances. Once you are let into the building, you will enter the area by the front offices, and cannot leave that area until the secretary checks you in. We just finished the process to secure an architectural firm to assist us in our designs. In addition, we are looking to enhance the camera system on campus. There will be additional safety changes that will be announced in the fall for students and campus visitors. Our goal is to always keep your child as safe as we possibly can and look forward to sharing the changes with the families and community as they get finalized.



So far, we have four seniors that will enter the military/ROTC (Reserved Officers Training Corps) when they graduate. I am extremely proud of these four young adults and their willingness to defend our freedom. The first two, Bo Donaldson and Makaylie Borton will enter the Marine Corps this summer. The third, McKenzie Mercer is finalizing her appointment in an ROTC program at the Citadel for the Marine Corp. The fourth is Jonah Childress who is entering the ROTC program at Bowling Green State University. If you know of another senior who has already been accepted to one of our military branches, please let me know so that I can write about them also.
