Seniors Take on 1984

Escape Room Lesson based on the Novel 1984 by George Orwell

Mrs. McKibben’s English classroom had a lesson that was more than just a game for her Advanced English 12 students. Their final mission was to find the lost diary of Winston Smith in a meager forty minutes, just before the “Thought Police” caught them.
