For informational purposes only, I want to let the community know that our income taxes are up for renewal and will be on the November ballot. There are two separate ballot issues, one for the ½ % and the other for the ¾ %. These two income tax levies have been renewed every 5 years since they were originally voted back in the early 90's and keeps the district from asking for new money to operate our schools. Please remember to vote on November 6th. These two renewals are NOT NEW TAXES, but are simply a continuation of the collections that have taken place for over 20 years.
