WHEREAS, this Board of Education at its meeting on the 13th day of March, 2023 by resolution duly adopted, determined the necessity of raising \$902,950 per year for School District purposes, and further provided that application be made to the Tax Commissioner of the Ohio Department of Taxation to estimate the property tax rate that would have to be imposed by the School District in the current year to produce said annual amount and to estimate the income tax rate that would have had to have been in effect for the current year as a School District income tax to produce said annual amount; and

WHEREAS, the Tax Commissioner of the Ohio Department of Taxation has certified to this Board of Education that the estimated property tax rate that would have to be imposed by the School District in the current year to produce said annual amount is 3.01 mills and that the estimated income tax rate that would have had to have been in effect for the current year as a School District income tax to produce said annual amount is 0.4525%;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Elmwood Local School District:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to Section 5748.02 of the Ohio Revised Code as amended (the "Act") renewal of a levy of an annual tax for the purpose of current expenses on the School District income of individuals and estates is hereby proposed and it is hereby determined to proceed with the submission to the electors of the School District the question of levying a renewal income tax of one-half percent (0.50%) per annum on the School District income of individuals and of estates for the purpose of current expenses for five years at the election to be held on November 7, 2023. Said tax, if approved by the electors, shall be effective January 1, 2026.

The income subject to the proposed tax is taxable income of individuals and estates as defined in divisions (E)(1)(a) and (2) of Section 5748.01 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 2. That the Treasurer of this Board of Education be and is hereby directed to immediately certify the following to the Board of Elections: (a) this resolution and (b) the estimated property tax rate that would have to be imposed in the current year to produce said annual amount and the estimated income tax rate that would have had to have been in effect for the current year as a School District income tax to produce said annual amount, as calculated and certified by the Tax Commissioner of the Ohio Department of Taxation, and to notify said Board of Elections to cause notice of such election to be given as required by law.
