



Community Talking Points

Jan. 26, 2020

- New groups are becoming eligible each week for COVID-19 vaccination during Phase 1B.
 - For eligibility criteria and the state's projected timeline for each group, go to <https://coronavirus.ohio.gov/wps/portal/gov/covid-19/covid-19-vaccination-program>
 - Vaccine appointments with Wood County Health Department will be posted for scheduling beginning at noon on Fridays.
 - If you will become eligible in the week that follows, you can schedule an appointment for the following Wednesday or later.
 - Each group that becomes eligible will have the opportunity to be served for one full week (Wednesday through the following Tuesday) before the next group becomes eligible.
 - Other local providers are doing their own registration and scheduling. Go to Vaccine.WoodCountyHealth.org to see current vaccine providers and their contact information.
 - If you would like to speak to someone to schedule an appointment, call 419-352-8402 and choose option 1.
 - We are continuing to serve those who became eligible during Phase 1A. Please fill out this form (<https://forms.gle/Lju4xWNgkTzYT2rX7>) so we can contact you; do not schedule an appointment.
- It is great to see a recent decrease in COVID-19 cases, but we all must remain vigilant.
 - You should continue to wear a mask and practice social distancing and other public health guidance, even after being vaccinated.
- Watch out for potential fraud related to COVID-19 response activities such as contact tracing and vaccine distribution.
 - WCHD will not ask for bank account or credit card information, or your social security number.
 - If you have concerns, ask for the caller's name and phone number, hang up, and call the Health Department at 419-352-8402 to verify their identity.
