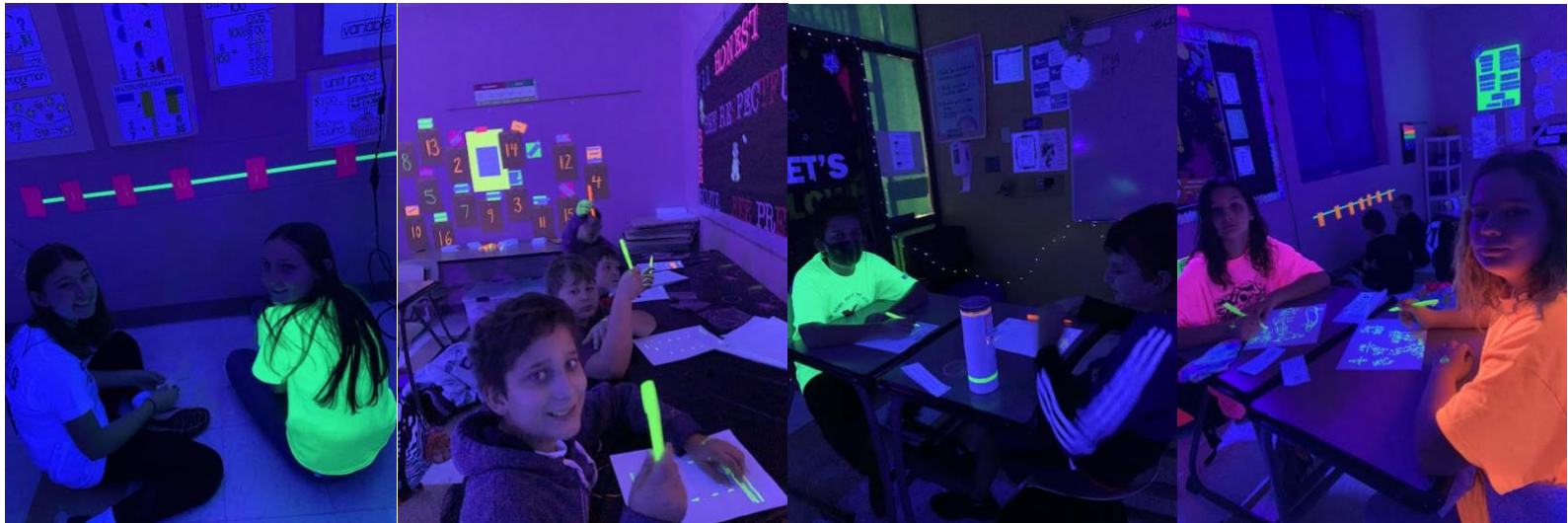


Elmwood Happenings 12/1/2021
