Elmwood will be helping to feed our students starting Wednesday, March 18th as the first pick up day.

We will offer food that is picked up at the main building one time per week and will give each child in your home a week's worth of breakfast and a week's worth of lunches for each kid in your family.

To accommodate working parents, we are actually going to do the pick-up from 5 to 7 in the evening. During these hours, you may come in the high school entrance or the board of education entrance to then go to the cafeteria for the pickup.

Again the goal is to provide food for the upcoming week and only require 1 trip out here to school.
