

Staff, Parents, and Community,

I am so excited to be back in school and ready to take on second semester. COVID concerns are still here, and my team is constantly working to keep everyone safe as can be and to lessen the spread of the disease. Here are a few notes to assist us moving forward.

1. Please keep your child home if they show any symptoms of being ill. Even if you do not think it is COVID, please keep the child home. This is our number one tool to stop the spread.
2. It is important to wash the masks your child is using frequently, this helps to keep them healthier.
3. As of writing, we are still following the quarantine rules from 1st semester. Gov. DeWine has indicated that this is changing, but until the Ohio Department of Health releases the order, we cannot change to this protocol. Once changed, we will not have to quarantine students who were in a classroom wearing mask but were exposed to a positive case. We will still quarantine if they are in close contact in the cafeteria, bus, or sporting practices/events. Again, this has not been authorized yet and we continue with the old rules for the time being.

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
