Time for another community update. I hope you are finding these of value and that I am not sending an excess of emails. Before I get into my points today, I just want to let everyone know I am thinking about our students, parents, and community. I miss seeing them in the halls and community events. Make sure you contact your child's teachers and principal if you have any concerns.

1. As previously stated, Governor DeWine has extended school closure through May 1st. I expect it to be extended again, but we will wait and see, and hope for the best. As a result, the musical has been cancelled.
2. Reminder that next week is spring break and there will be no lessons from Monday, April 6th through Monday, April 13th. Online learning will resume on Tuesday, April 14th. Meals during spring break are being handled by a different group and we will send information via phone and email on Monday the 6th to give everyone details.
3. After spring break, we have asked staff to post lessons, at the most, 4 days per week. Our hope is that your child will see a little decrease in the amount of time it takes to complete everything. The day the teacher's do not post will vary, based on teacher's plans for the week.
4. I am hearing a lot of concerns about teachers responding to emails. I want to let everyone know that we told teachers to generally answer emails during normal business hours. I know that there are teachers who prefer to answer when they come in, into the evening. This is OK, but please understand that some staff decided to do the business hours' email only. Either is acceptable. The staff will get back to you or your child and will give them plenty of time to get the work done after the response.

5. EHS Student Council will be selling flowers during the month of April. The flowers will be through Bench's Greenhouse in Elmore, Ohio. All proceeds made will go back to feeding our community during this pandemic.
 - The sale ends Friday, April 24th
 - The flowers will be available for pick up Thursday, May 7th at the Ag workshop.
