Here are updates from the school and from our community partners:

1. If a child is missing school due to the fact that they are waiting on a COVID test result (or if a family member is waiting on results and the child is being held from school), please call into the school and talk with the nurse to notify her of this information. It helps us keep track of potential student COVID cases.
2. Great Lakes Community Action Partnership (GLCAP) now has CARES Act COVID Relief funds for eligible residents of Ottawa, Sandusky, Seneca and Wood counties. **Funds can assist families who are behind on mortgage, rent, and/or water and sewer utility payments due to financial hardships caused by COVID-19.**
